

OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT

Subject: Update regarding the Technical Capacity of participants, and more specifically concerning quality assurance certificates for the project entitled: “Addition (construction) of a Control Tower – Access for Transport and Stacking Equipment of Open Pillar Type (Straddle Carriers) at the Container Terminal of OLTH S.A.”

We hereby inform you that, with reference to Article 2.2.1(iv), certification of the participant in accordance with **EN ISO 15614** (welding procedure/design code) is required, either by the participant itself or by a subcontractor to be declared by the participant for the execution of the project.

In the event that a subcontractor is used to meet the **Technical Capacity** requirements, each submission must be accompanied by a **list of subcontractors**, and the relevant **certificate of the subcontractor** must be included in the submission dossier.

In the event of reliance on the technical and professional capacity of a third party (subcontractor), a relevant written commitment from that third party must be submitted, demonstrating that the necessary resources will be made available to the participant for the entire duration of the contract execution.

With regard to the remaining quality certificates, these must be provided in accordance with the published Invitation to Tender. In case any certificate is under issuance or renewal, a document evidencing the issuance or renewal process by the competent certification body must be included in the submission dossier.

Furthermore, please be informed of the following amendment to **Article 2.3 “Submission of a Tender by an Association of Economic Operators”** of the present tender document:

“2.3.2. In the case of submission of a tender by an association of economic operators, the above-mentioned Quality Criteria under 2.2.1 (i), (ii) and (iv) must be fulfilled by at least one member of the association.

2.3.3. In the case of submission of a tender by an association of economic operators, the above-mentioned Quality Criterion under 2.2.1 (iii) must be fulfilled by each member of the association.”

This notice expressly amends Articles 2.3.2 and 2.3.3 and prevails over any conflicting reference in the RFP.

Concerning the conduct of a **site visit at the project location**, this may be arranged no later than the deadline for the submission of questions, which in the present case is **Wednesday, 10 June 2026**.
