SUBJECT: Answers to questions submitted in the framework of the Tenders 001 & 002/2020, of ThPA SA, for the sale and removal of old equipment / machinery and other materials, as scrap and for the Clearance of old equipment/machinery.

1. Following the question regarding the collection-transfer licenses and if they are no longer valid as they have been replaced by the insurance policies of civil liability for the environment, according to Law 4685/2020, it is confirmed that the sign in and registration from 07.05.2020, is now required of the collector in the Electronic Waste Register (HMA) and the contracting of an insurance policy in accordance with the terms of this Law and specifically it is stated that the insurance coverage concerns third parties and the restoration of the environment to the previous situation in case of damage, amounting to at least one hundred thousand (100,000) euros per year
That is, the permit for the collection and transport of non-hazardous waste is explicitly abolished.
2. It is stated that the Contractor may use Machinery of ThPA SA, (cutting, transportation, various works), provided that the machines will be available upon request, paying the respective invoice costs, in accordance with the applicable tariff provided for each of them.
